

Corplex Inc., of Northfield Illinois, has announced plans to expand its current fleet of mobile production units. Scheduled for August 1<sup>st</sup> 2008 availability, HD Mobile Unit Iridium and Support unit Zinc will be two new additions to Corplex's current mobile lineup which include: HD unit Platinum, with support unit Mercury and SD units Sterling and Copper. "We have had great response with Platinum since it went on line and our clients have been asking for additional HD capacity" says Scott West, President / Partner. The new units are being designed in house at Corplex. Heading up this design team is Corplex's V.P. / Partner, Dave Greany who has more than 18 years mobile and EIC experience. Gerling and Associates, Sunbury, Ohio will construct the trailers and systems integration will be completed by Little Bay Broadcast Services of New Hampshire. "HD gear has reached a high level of development so in many ways the design of the unit can be much simpler than even 2 years ago. But that doesn't mean cutting corners or slimming down on infrastructure" sites Dave Greany. "We will be outfitting Iridium with all the gear our clients expect but also build on our own design successes and ideas".

In many ways, the traditional mobile unit design just doesn't make sense anymore. As a result, Iridium will incorporate unique design philosophies in layout and infrastructure to address the changing marketplace. "I think production teams will love what we are going to do in Iridium and based on the success of support unit Mercury's design concepts, I know that Zinc, our new B unit will only improve on a great layout and design" says Greany.

Iridium will be able operate as a standalone A unit and will not require a Support unit for normal operations. "Many of our clients still request an additional support unit for their productions, so we knew that building Zinc concurrently with Iridium would allow us to fully service those customers. Engineering Iridium to stand on its own will give us the flexibility to be competitive for single day set, shoot, strike events and adding the support unit will make the pair a perfect choice for network level productions." That being said, Scott West presses on, "Corplex's strength lies not only in a well designed mobile unit, but more importantly in our employees. We operate as a team and have been able to provide clients with personalized treatment from the office, shop and field."

Both Iridium and Zinc will be available for preview in the outdoor exhibit area at the 2008 NAB convention in Las Vegas. Zinc will be in the Gerling and Associates booth OE 100, while Iridium will be in Corplex's own booth OE 325.
